Potential priority areas for exploration identified

LITERATURE AND RESOURCE SCAN

- Does enough suitable Australian and/or international evidence exist to respond to this priority area?
- What evidence based resources already exist?

REVIEW AND REFINE

- Refine the priority area in view of stakeholder feedback and existing evidence and material
- Identify details, criteria, goals and process for systematic review and transitional products

STAKEHOLDER ENGAGEMENT

Test and verify with end user representatives and refine according to feedback

PROCEED TO COMMISSIONING RESEARCH TO ACTION GUIDES

Engage with communities of practice throughout development to test the Guides in the field. Validate the content of Research to Action Guides through expert peer review.

PUBLICATION AND PROMOTION

- Add research to Action Guide to the CADR Clearing House's assessed collection
- Promote new resource to all end users
- Seek feedback on research to Action Guides, and build into project plan
